NEW TOURISM DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS FOR NER

2059 SHRI AJIT KUMAR BHUYAN:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) the new tourism development projects conceptualised and being implemented in the NER during the last five years, indicating sanction, implementation status and funding pattern thereof;
- (b) the list of new proposals in the pipeline and status thereof; and
- (c) the latest trend of national and international tourist flow into the region, including natural and spiritual sites, during the last three years?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(a) & (b): Ministry of Tourism under the schemes of 'Swadesh Darshan', 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' & 'Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development' provides financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territory Administrations/Central Agencies for the development of tourism related infrastructure and facilities at various tourism destinations in the country including North Eastern Region.

The Ministry of Tourism has now revamped the Swadesh Darshan Scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD 2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible tourism destinations, following a destination & tourism centric approach.

The details of projects sanctioned under the above mentioned schemes in North Eastern region are given at **Annexure-I**.

Additionally, some destinations in the North Eastern region have been identified for development under SD 2.0, PRASHAD and "Challenge Based Destination Development" sub-scheme of Swadesh Darshan 2.0. The details of these identified destinations are at **Annexure-II**.

The proposals for projects at identified destinations are formulated by the concerned State Governments/UT Administrations. Reviewing and sanctioning of the projects is an ongoing process and is done as per procedures and requirements stipulated in the scheme guidelines.

The Swadesh Darshan and PRASHAD Schemes are Central Sector Schemes under which 100% fund is provided by the Ministry for Tourism to the concerned State Governments/UT Administrations. The funds are sanctioned and released to the Implementing Agencies in instalments as per the provision of the extant scheme guidelines and in conformity with the other instructions and directions issued by the Government of India from time to time.

Under the scheme of "Assistance to central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development" Central Financial Assistance up to Rs.50 Crore is provided to Central Agencies for developing tourism infrastructure.
