#### **FUNDS FOR PROMOTION OF TOURISM**

### Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the assistance being extended to the State Government of Himachal Pradesh by the Union Government keeping in mind the immense opportunities of tourism;
- (b) the details of the approved budgetary allocations to promote tourism in Himachal Pradesh during the last ten years, schemewise and district-wise:
- (c) whether the Government proposes to formulate any scheme for increasing the number of tourists in Kangra and Chamba districts of Himachal Pradesh; and
- (d) whether the State Government of Himachal Pradesh has sent any proposals to the Government for the schemes to promote tourism in the State and if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

#### THE MINISTER OF TOURISM (SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

(a) to (d): Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned a project 'Development of Himalayan Circuit: Kiarighat, Shimla, Hatkoti, Manali, Kangra, Dharamshala, Bir, Palampur, Chamba' in the year 2016-17 for a cost of Rs.68.34 Crore out of which Rs.64.54 Crore has been released.

Financial assistance has also been provided to the State Government of Himachal Pradesh for organising fairs/festivals and tourism related events under Domestic Promotion & Publicity including Hospitality (DPPH) Scheme as per details given below:
