The Ministry through its central sector scheme of 'Swadesh Darshan (SD)' and 'PRASHAD', complements the efforts of the State Governments/UT Administrations for tourism infrastructure development by extending them financial assistance in consultation with them. Under the Swadesh Darshan (SD) scheme, the Ministry has supported and sanctioned for the development works at Anandpur Sahib – Fatehgarh Sahib – Chamkaur Sahib – Ferozpur – Khatkar Kalan – Kalanour – Patiala. Similarly, under the National Mission on 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive' (PRASHAD) scheme, Ministry of Tourism sanctioned projects at Karuna Sagar, Valmiki Sthal, Amritsar, Chamkaur Sahib, Ropar (Roopnagar).

Ministry of Tourism also promotes tourism destinations and products of India including both in domestic and global markets. Promotion is carried out through various initiatives including events and social media.
