PROMOTION OF TOURISM IN NER

450 SHRI BIRENDRA PRASAD BAISHYA:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) the new initiatives or strategies put in place to draw both local and foreign tourists to the North-East;
- (b) Government's proposed plan for North Eastern Region's (NER's) basic infrastructure with contemporary facilities, smooth movement across States, and clean tourist destinations; and
- (c) the details of the steps taken by Government to ensure adequate security to tourists?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

(a) to (b): Ministry of Tourism promotes India in a holistic manner, through various initiatives under its Schemes of "Domestic Promotion & Publicity including Hospitality" (DPPH) and "Overseas Promotion & Publicity (OPP)" including North Eastern Region. As part of its on-going activities; it regularly releases print, electronic, online and outdoor media campaigns in the international markets, to promote various tourism destinations and products of India. The Ministry of Tourism also regularly promotes various tourism destinations and products through its website and social media promotions.

Ministry of Tourism in collaboration with Meghalaya Tourism organised 11th edition of International Tourism Mart at Shillong, Meghalaya from 21st to 23rd, November, 2023. The International Tourism Mart is a key event organised by the Ministry in one of the North Eastern States on rotation basis, with an objective to provide a bigger platform to the North Eastern stakeholders to interact with their counterparts from both within the country and overseas markets as well as to create awareness about the tourism potential of North East Region (NER). The event aims to showcase Northeast India's tourism potential, biodiversity, and cultural heritage to domestic and international audiences.

Financial assistance has also been provided to the North Eastern States for organizing fairs/ festivals & tourism related events under Domestic Promotion & Publicity including Hospitality (DPPH) Scheme. Details of funds sanctioned in the last five years for the North Eastern States are at **Annexure I.**

Ministry of Tourism under the schemes of 'Swadesh Darshan', 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)', 'Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development' provides financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territory Administrations/Central Agencies for the development of tourism related infrastructure and facilities at various tourism destinations in

the country including NER.

The Ministry of Tourism has now revamped the Swadesh Darshan Scheme as Swadesh darshan 2.0 (SD 2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible tourism destinations, following a destination & tourism centric approach.

The details of projects sanctioned under the above mentioned schemes in North Eastern region are given at **Annexure II**.

The implementation of the activities under the above mentioned Schemes are an ongoing activity. Proposals are received from States/UTs from time to time for seeking financial assistance under the various schemes of the Ministry of Tourism. These proposals are extended for projects subject to fulfilment of the stipulated provisions and availability of funds.

Considering the importance of cleanliness & hygiene, Ministry of Tourism implements Swachhta Action Plan at various tourist destinations at PAN India basis including the states of North Eastern Regions through Indian Institute of Tourism and Travel Management (IITTM), Gwalior, Central Institute of Hotel Managements (CIHMs), State Institute of Hotel Managements (SIHMs) and Food Craft Institutes (FCIs).

Ministry of Tourism organizes various cleanliness activities across the country like Swachhta Pakhwada and Swachhta Hi Sewa.

Further, promotion of tourism in the North Eastern Region (NER) is among the focused and priority sectors of Ministry of Development of North Eastern (MDoNER). MDoNER is implementing various projects including projects for development of tourism sector in NER under various schemes viz. North East Special Infrastructure Development Scheme (NESIDS); Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North East Region (PM-Dev INE) and Scheme of North Eastern Council.

(c): Security of tourists is essentially a State Government subject. However, the Ministry of Tourism has taken up the matter with all State Governments/Union Territory (UT) Administrations for setting up of dedicated Tourism Police. With the efforts of Ministry of Tourism, the State Governments/UT Administrations of Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Delhi, Goa, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim and Uttar Pradesh have deployed tourist police in one form or the other.

Ministry of Tourism through Indian Institute of Tourism & Travel Management (IITTM) conducted a study on "Functioning of Tourist Police in States/UTs & Documentation of Best Practices", to understand the requirement of tourist police and sensitizing the tourist police towards the needs of the tourists, which was sent to all the States/UTs. A training module, as given by IITTM for imparting training has also been circulated to State Governments/UT Administrations.

With the objective of implementation of Uniform Tourist Police across all the States/UTs to create a safer ecosystem for the tourists, Ministry of Tourism in collaboration with the Ministry of Home Affairs and Bureau of Police Research and Development (BPR&D) organized a National Conference on Tourist Police Scheme of Director Generals (DGs)/Inspector Generals (IGs) of Police Department of all the States/UTs in October, 2022.

The Ministry of Tourism has set up a 24x7 Multi-Lingual Tourist Info-Helpline on the toll free number 1800111363 or on a short code 1363 in 12 Languages including 10 international languages (German, French, Spanish, Italian, Portuguese, Russian, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Arabic), Hindi & English for domestic and foreign tourists to provide support service in term of information relating to Travel in India and to offer appropriate guidance to tourists in distress while travelling in India.
