For this, the candidates should register for online counselling to be conducted by the NIC, schedule of which will be notified in due course.

The Three-year B.Sc. Hospitality & Hotel Administration (HHA) Program is run in academic collaboration with Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU), New Delhi. Degrees are awarded by the JNU to the candidates who successfully complete this program.
