R&A division brings out this monthly bulletin that mainly focuses tourism statistics related to foreign tourist arrivals(FTA), Indian national departure(IND), estimation of Foreign exchange earnings(FEE) from tourism and international scenario of tourism statistics on the basis of latest available UNWTO barometer.





# 1.Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs)

- 1.1 FTAs in December, 2024 were 10,28,765 as compared to 11,01,914 in December, 2023 and 12,26,398 in December, 2019 registering a growth of -6.6% and -16.1% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- **1.2** FTAs during the period January-December, 2024 were 96,57,003 as compared to 95,20,928 in January-December 2023 and 1,09,30,355 in January-December, 2019 registering a growth of 1.4% and -11.6% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.






1.6 Percentage Share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during December 2024 and January-December 2024 among the top 5 ports




# 2. Foreign Exchange Earnings(FEEs)

- **2.1** FEEs during the month of December 2024 were Rs.32,788 crores as compared to Rs.24,707 crores in December 2023 and Rs.22,873 Crore in December, 2019 registering a growth of 32.71% and 43.35% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- **2.2** FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of December 2024 were US\$ 3.858 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.967 billion during the month of December 2023 and US\$ 3.211 billion in December, 2019 registering a growth of 30.03% and 20.15% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.




- **2.3** FEEs during the period January-December 2024 were Rs.2,77,842 crores as compared to Rs.2,31,927 crores in January-December 2023 and Rs.2,16,467 Crore in January-December, 2019 registering a growth of 19.80% and 28.35% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- **2.4** FEE during the period January- December 2024 were US\$ 33.185 billion as compared to US\$ 28.077 billion in January- December 2023 and US\$ 30.721 billion January- December 2019 registering a growth of 18.19% and 8.02% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.






- 3.1 INDs in December 2024 were 26,43,377 as compared to 25,23,271 in December 2023 and 23,55,977 in December 2019 registering a growth of 4.76% and 12.20% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- 3.2 INDs during the period January- December, 2024 were 3,02,30,507 as compared to 2,78,77,640 in January- December, 2023 and 2,69,15,034 in January-December 2019 registering a growth of 8.44% and 12.32% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.



3.3 Percentage Share of Indian Nationals' Departures during December 2024 and during January to December 2024 among the top 5 source countries




# 3.4 Purpose wise percentage share of Indian Nationals' Departures during December 2024 and during January to December 2024






3.6 Percentage Share of INDs during December 2024 and January-December 2024 among the top 5 ports


