

R&A division brings out this monthly bulletin that mainly focuses tourism statistics related to foreign tourist arrivals(FTA), Indian national departure(IND), estimation of Foreign exchange earnings(FEE) from tourism and international scenario of tourism statistics on the basis of latest available UNWTO barometer.





1.Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs)

- 1.1 FTAs in November, 2024 were 9,47,610 as compared to 9,48,631 in November, 2023 and 10,92,440 in November, 2019 registering a growth of -0.1% and -13.3% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- 1.2 FTAs during the period January-November, 2024 were 86,28,238 as compared to 84,19,014 in January-November 2023 and 97,03,957 in January-November, 2019 registering a growth of 2.5% and -11.1% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.






1.3 Percentage Share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during November 2024 and during January to November 2024 among the top 5 source countries





1.4 Purpose wise percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during November 2024 and during January to November 2024





1.6 Percentage Share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during November 2024 and January-November 2024 among the top 5 ports






2.Foreign Exchange Earnings(FEEs)

- **2.1** FEEs during the month of November 2024 were Rs.28,295 crores as compared to Rs.21,552 crores in November 2023 and Rs.20,372 Crore in November, 2019 registering a growth of 31.29% and 38.89% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
 - **2.2** FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of November 2024 were US\$ 3.354 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.587 billion during the month of November 2023 and US\$ 2.860 billion in November, 2019 registering a growth of 29.64% and 17.27% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.



- **2.3** FEEs during the period January-November 2024 were Rs.2,45,054 crores as compared to Rs.2,07,220 crores in January-November 2023 and Rs.1,93,594 Crore in January-November, 2019 registering a growth of 18.26% and 26.58% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- **2.4** FEE during the period January- November 2024 were US\$ 29.327 billion as compared to US\$ 25.110 billion in January- November 2023 and US\$ 27.510 billion January- November 2019 registering a growth of 16.79% and 6.60% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.






- **3.1** INDs in November 2024 were 24,99,819 as compared to 22,30,311 in November 2023 and 21,47,330 in November 2019 registering a growth of 12.08% and 16.41% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- **3.2** INDs during the period January- November, 2024 were 2,75,87,130 as compared to 2,53,54,369 in January- November, 2023 and 2,45,59,057 in January-November 2019 registering a growth of 8.81% and 12.33% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.




3.3 Percentage Share of Indian Nationals' Departures during November 2024 and during January to November 2024 among the top 5 source countries




3.4 Purpose wise percentage share of Indian Nationals' Departures during November 2024 and during January to November 2024



3.5 Gender wise distribution




3.6 Percentage Share of INDs during November 2024 and January-November 2024 among the top 5 ports


