INCLUSION OF BUXAR IN PRASHAD SCHEME

1128. SHRI SUDHAKAR SINGH:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of the PRASHAD (Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Heritage Augmentation Drive) scheme and the number of projects that have been implemented under this scheme across the country;
- (b) whether the Government has considered inclusion of Buxar, Bihar, under the PRASHAD scheme, given its historical and spiritual significance as the land where Lord Ram received his education and the site of the famous Panchkosi Parikrama Mela, if so, the details thereof:
- (c) the details of the specific steps being taken by the Government to develop and promote tourism in Buxar, including infrastructure development, heritage preservation and marketing of its cultural significance; and
- (d) whether the Government has any plan to collaborate with the Bihar Government to enhance pilgrimage and cultural tourism in Buxar and other historically significant sites in the State and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM (SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

(a): The Ministry of Tourism under the "Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive" (PRASHAD) Scheme provides financial assistance to the State Governments and Union Territory Administrations for development of tourism infrastructure at identified pilgrimage and heritage destinations.

The Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned 47 projects in 27 States/UTs with

estimated cost of Rs.1594.40 crore till date. Details of the projects sanctioned under the PRASHAD Scheme including their status is given in the annexure.

(b) to (d): No proposal is under consideration of the Ministry of Tourism for inclusion of Buxar, Bihar under the PRASHAD Scheme. However, the Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned two projects in Bihar under the said scheme namely, 'Development at Patna Sahib' and 'Development of basic facilities at Vishnupad temple'. In addition, the Ministry of Tourism has identified two sites for development under the PRASHAD Scheme viz. Simariya Ghat, Begusarai District and Aami Mandir, Saran District in Bihar.

The Ministry of Tourism as part of its ongoing endeavour also promotes various tourism destinations and products of the country including Buxar in Bihar through promotional activities, events, website, social media promotions etc.

Receiving proposals from the State Governments/UT Administrations for financial assistance for tourism projects is a continuous process. The proposals received are examined with reference to the prescribed guidelines and financial assistance is extended for such projects subject to fulfilment of the stipulated conditions and availability of funds.
