**PROVISION OF FACILITIES AT TOURISM HOTSPOTS**

**65. SHRI PUTTA MAHESH KUMAR:**

**Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:**

- (a) the number of monuments, locations and areas identified by the Government to have heavy tourist (domestic and international) footfall and identified as tourism hotspots across the country, particularly in Andhra Pradesh;**
- (b) whether the Government has undertaken any recent survey/study regarding the status of infrastructure and facilities at such tourism hotspots in the country, particularly in Andhra Pradesh;**
- (c) if so, the total number of such areas which have been identified to be lacking basic facilities such as toilets (male, female and others), ramps, rest-rooms, registered guides and drinking water facilities; and**
- (d) the details of steps taken by the Government to resolve these issues during the last five years along with the funds allocated/utilised, State-wise, particularly in Andhra Pradesh?**

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF TOURISM (SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)**

**(a) to (d): The Ministry of Tourism has conducted a study on "Assessment of Tourist Destinations in Areas of Infrastructure and Cleanliness" to evaluate 185 tourist sites across 53 destinations in 29 States and Union Territories including Andhra Pradesh. The sites and destinations were evaluated based on four key elements, namely: accessibility, amenities, hygiene and safety & security.**

**The above mentioned study covered total 8 sites in Andhra Pradesh across various themes. The sites assessed include:**

- 1. Mallikarjuna Swamy Temple (Srisailam)**

- 2. Bhramaramba Devi Temple (Srisailam)**
- 3. Srisailam Wildlife Sanctuary (Srisailam)**
- 4. Chandavaram Buddhist Site (Amaravati)**
- 5. Amareswara Temple (Amaravati)**
- 6. Kanaka Durga Temple (Amaravati)**
- 7. Nagarjunkhonda (Amaravati)**
- 8. Undavalli Caves (Amaravati)**

**The Ministry of Tourism under the schemes of 'Swadesh Darshan', 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' and 'Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development' provides financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territory Administrations/Central Agencies for the development of tourism-related infrastructure and facilities at various tourism destinations in the country, including the State of Andhra Pradesh.**

**Ministry of Tourism revamped its Swadesh Darshan Scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible tourism destinations following a tourist & destination centric approach.**

**The details of projects sanctioned under the above-mentioned schemes are given in the Annexure.**
