**STATEMENT** IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.314# ANSWERED ON 21.08.2025 REGARDING DEVELOPMENT OF CRUISE TOURISM IN THE COUNTRY RAISED BY SHRI MAHENDRA BHATT

(a) to (c): Development and promotion of tourist destinations and products, including Cruise tourism, is primarily the responsibility of the respective State Government/Union Territory (UT) Administration. However, as part of its on-going activities, the Ministry of Tourism regularly promotes India as a holistic tourism destination including Cruise tourism through various mediums including social media and websites.

The Ministry complements the efforts of States/UTs through various schemes and initiatives. Ministry of Tourism provides Central Financial Assistance (CFA) to the Central Government Agencies for development of tourism including Cruise Tourism, on receipt of complete proposals under the Scheme of 'Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development'. The list of projects sanctioned under Assistance to Central Agencies, is given in Annexure.

A Task Force on Cruise Tourism has been formed jointly by the Ministry of Tourism and Ministry of Shipping with representatives of all major ports and stakeholders for coordinated efforts to create an enabling ecosystem for the development of Cruise Tourism in India.

The Task Force has formulated Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) to be followed by the various agencies for handling of cruise ships. To standardize these procedures, the Ministry of Tourism issued SOP-3 in June 2025, developed in consultation with all stakeholders to provide a unified framework for cruise operations in India. It clearly defines roles and processes to ensure security, efficiency and passenger satisfaction, supporting India's vision of emerging as a global cruise tourism hub.

As conveyed by the Ministry of Ports, Shipping & Waterways (MoPSW), the details of development in Cruise Shipping is as under:

- (i) Cruise ports are located at Mumbai (Maharashtra), Murmugao (Goa), Kochi (Kerala), Chennai (Tamil Nadu), New Mangalore (Karanataka), and Visakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh), with cruise calls also at Puducherry (Union Territory), Lakshadweep (Union Territory), and Sri Vijayapuram (Andaman and Nicobar Islands).
- (ii) Cordelia Cruises has started operations from Puducherry on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2025 as cruise destination.

- (iii) During FY 2024 25, 29 National Waterways (NWs) were operational across 11 states, including 3 NWs exclusively designated for cruise movement.
- (iv) The comparative data of past decade shows increase in Cruise ship traffic as below:
  - In FY 2013-14, 102 cruise vessels with carried 84,705 passengers.
  - In FY 2024-25, 272 cruise vessels carried 4,92,362 passengers.
