TOURISM PROJECTS UNDER SWADESH DARSHAN AND PRASHAD SCHEMES IN MAHARASHTRA

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of tourism infrastructure projects sanctioned under Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD, or other central schemes in Maharashtra during the last five years;
- (b) the current status of these projects completed, ongoing, or delayed with reasons for delay, if any;
- (c) the amount of central assistance disbursed and utilised under each scheme, district-wise in Maharashtra:
- (d) whether State Government has requested new projects for heritage circuits or eco-tourism; and
- (e) the details of steps Ministry is taking to promote lesser-known destinations in Maharashtra like Lonar, Sindhudurg, and Mangi-Tungi?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(a) to (e): Development and promotion of tourist destinations and tourism products is primarily undertaken by the respective State Government / Union Territory (UT) Administration. However, the Ministry of Tourism through its central sector schemes of 'Swadesh Darshan(SD)', 'Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0)', 'Challenge Based Destination Development (CBDD)' – a sub-scheme of Swadesh Darshan, 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' and 'Assistance to Central Agencies (ACA) for Tourism Infrastructure Development' schemes complements the efforts of tourism infrastructure development by extending financial assistance to the State Governments /Union Territory Administrations/Central Agencies. Receipt of the project proposals from the State Governments/ UT Administrations under different schemes is an ongoing process. The projects are considered for sanctioning on receipt of the DPRs in line with the guidelines and other instructions issued in this regard, availability of the funds, prescribed parameters, inter-se priority etc.

In addition, Government of India under its initiative for 'Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment (SASCI)' has also provided financial assistance to the States for development of tourism projects.

The Ministry of Tourism does not release district-wise funds in respect of sanctioned projects. The details of sanctioned projects under the SD2.0, CBDD, ACA and SASCI schemes in the last five years in the State of Maharashtra is annexed.

The Ministry of Tourism as part of its ongoing promotional activities regularly promotes various tourism destinations and products of the country including lesser known destinations of Maharashtra, in the international and domestic markets through social media, promotional websites, events etc.
