**CAPACITY BUILDING FOR SERVICE PROVIDERS SCHEME**

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of persons provided training in tourism sector under Capacity Building for Service Providers (CBSP) Scheme since the inception of the scheme particularly in the State of Uttarakhand;
- (b) the number of such trained persons who have got employment or have started rural tourism, home-stay or other self-employment activities;
- (c) whether women and youth from backward, hilly and tribal areas of Uttarakhand are being provided adequate access to these training programmes; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d): Under the scheme of “Capacity Building for Service Providers” (CBSP), Ministry of Tourism conducts the training programmes all across the country. As per the information available, a total of 5.54 lakh individuals have been trained and 25250 have been trained in Uttarakhand since inception of scheme. The outcome of these training includes placements, self-employment, entrepreneurship and persons opting for higher studies. 59210 persons have been placed after completing the training.

All the government and empanelled institute advertise the training programs through various channels before conducting the training which makes this effective in reaching to a diverse group of candidates, women and youth from backward, hilly and tribal areas of country including in the State of Uttarakhand.
