- (a) the details of 'Paryatan Mitra' and 'Paryatan Didi' initiatives launched at national level in the year 2024; and
- (b) the increase in the number of visitors, security mechanism and local participation due to the implementation of 'Bharat Rannbhoomi Darshan' initiative?

ANSWER

(a): Ministry of Tourism launched a National responsible tourism initiative by the name of Paryatan Mitra/Paryatan Didi. The initiative was piloted in 6 tourist destinations across India namely – Orchha (Madhya Pradesh), Gandikota (Andhra Pradesh), Bodh Gaya (Bihar), Aizawl (Mizoram), Jodhpur (Rajasthan) and Shri Vijaya Puram (Andaman & Nicobar Islands).

In the pilot phase, more than 4,000 people have been trained. The programme has now been extended all across the country.

(b): Bharat Rannbhoomi Darshan is an initiative of Ministry of Defence. As per the information available on the Bharat Rannbhoomi Darshan Portal developed by Ministry of Defence, Government of India, no such specific data has been compiled.
