TOURISM DEVELOPMENT AND RURAL EMPLOYMENT IN HERITAGE-RICH DISTRICTS

626 SMT. GEETA ALIAS CHANDRAPRABHA:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has identified tourism potential in underdeveloped yet heritage-rich districts such as Etawah and Auraiya for development under Swadesh Darshan or PRASHAD schemes;
- (b) the number and status of rural infrastructure projects sanctioned in these locations for tourism enhancement;
- (c) whether Government has created homestay models, cultural circuits, or livelihood generation plans linked to tourism; and
- (d) the quantum of rural employment generated and role of local women in such projects?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

(a) to (d): Development and promotion of tourist destinations and tourism products is primarily undertaken by the respective State Government/Union Territory (UT) Administration. However, the Ministry of Tourism through its central sector schemes of 'Swadesh Darshan(SD)', Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0), 'Challenge Based Destination Development (CBDD)' – a sub-scheme of Swadesh Darshan and 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' and 'Assistance to Central Agencies (ACA) for Tourism Infrastructure Development' schemes complements the efforts of tourism infrastructure development by extending financial assistance to the State Governments/UT Administrations/Central Agencies subject to availability of funds, adherence to scheme guidelines, and submission of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) by the State Government etc. In addition, Government of India under its initiative for 'Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment (SASCI) has also provided financial assistance to the States for development of tourism projects. The Ministry of Tourism under the above-mentioned schemes has provided financial assistance to the State of Uttar Pradesh for development of tourism projects, details of which is annexed.

The projects are identified based on the project proposals submitted by the concerned State Governments, its examination on the prescribed parameters and as per the institutional framework detailed in the scheme guidelines.

Presently, there is no proposal before the Ministry of Tourism submitted by the State Government of Uttar Pradesh, in line with the scheme guidelines and other instructions issued in this regard, for sanctioning projects in the districts of Etawah and Auraiya.

With the aim to promote tourism in tribal areas, the Ministry of Tourism has recently issued guidelines for 'Development of Homestays in Tribal Areas' along with template for formulation of proposal by State Governments and UT Administrations.
