PROMOTION OF TOURISM IN JAMMU & KASHMIR

612. SHRI SAT PAUL SHARMA:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has plans to promote tourism in Jammu and Kashmir;
- (b) if so, the details of proposed schemes or plans along with the timelines set for their implementation;
- (c) whether Government has undertaken any recent assessment of infrastructure gaps such as last-mile connectivity, accommodation capacity and safety facilities for tourists; and
- (d) if so, the outcome of such assessments?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(a) to (d): Development and promotion of tourist destinations and tourism products including assessment of infrastructure gaps is primarily undertaken by the respective State Government/Union Territory (UT) Administration. However, the Ministry of Tourism through its different schemes such as 'Swadesh Darshan' and 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' etc. provides financial assistance to the State Governments/UT Administrations for development of tourism infrastructure and experiences in the country subject to availability of funds, adherence to scheme guidelines and submission of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) etc. by the concerned State/UT. The details of the projects sanctioned under Swadesh Darshan and PRASHAD schemes in the UT of Jammu & Kashmir is **Annexed**.

Depending on the requirement, the components sanctioned under the projects may include those related to last mile connectivity, log huts, CCTV, items of public convenience etc.

Ministry of Tourism also promotes various tourist destinations and products of the country including those in J&K in a holistic manner. Such promotions are undertaken through various ongoing initiatives such as social media posts, promotional website, tourism related events, extending support to tourism related fairs and festivals, participation in road shows etc.
