
## Foreign Tourist Inflow to India November, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs during the month of November, 2022.

## **Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):**

- FTAs in November, 2022 were 7,68,675 as compared to 2,63,867 in November, 2021 and 10,92,440 in November, 2019 registering a growth of 191.3% and -29.6% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- November, 2022 were 52,25,129 as compared to 12,09,467 in January-November, 2021 and 97,03,957 in January-November, 2019 registering a growth of 332.0% and -46.2% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during November, 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (20.49%) followed by Bangladesh (19.37%), UK (8.52%), Australia (6.46%), Canada (5.12%), Russian Fed. (2.62%), Germany (2.53%), Singapore (2.42%), Sri Lanka (2.40%), Malaysia (1.95%), France (1.86%), Nepal (1.72%), Thailand (1.39%), New Zealand (1.12%) and Japan (1.10%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-November, 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (22.09%), followed by Bangladesh (20.46%), UK (10.13%), Australia (5.26%), Canada (4.52%), Sri Lanka (3.05%), Nepal (2.30%), Germany (2.05%), France (1.87%), Singapore (1.86%), Malaysia (1.83%), Russian Federation (1.37%), Maldives (1.15%), Portugal (1.12%), & Oman (1.00%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during November 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (31.48%) followed by Mumbai Airport (17.11%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (8.95%), Chennai Airport (7.21%), Bengaluru Airport (6.23%), Hyderabad Airport (3.81%), Kolkata Airport (3.71%), Cochin Airport (3.01%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.86%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (2.23%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (1.94%), Changrabandha Land Check Post (1.20%), Amritsar Airport (1.20%), Chitpur Rail Check Post (1.13%) and Tiruchirappalli Airport (1.03%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-November 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (31.78%) followed by Mumbai Airport (14.13%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (9.54%), Chennai Airport (9.51%), Bengaluru Airport (6.36%), Hyderabad Airport (4.76%), Cochin Airport

(4.43%), Kolkata Airport (3.88%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.70%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (1.56%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.37%), Trivandrum Airport (1.35%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (1.09%), Tiruchirappalli Airport (1.05%) and Changrabandha Land Check Post (1.02%).
