

Foreign Tourist Inflow to India February, 2023

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs during the month of February, 2023.

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):

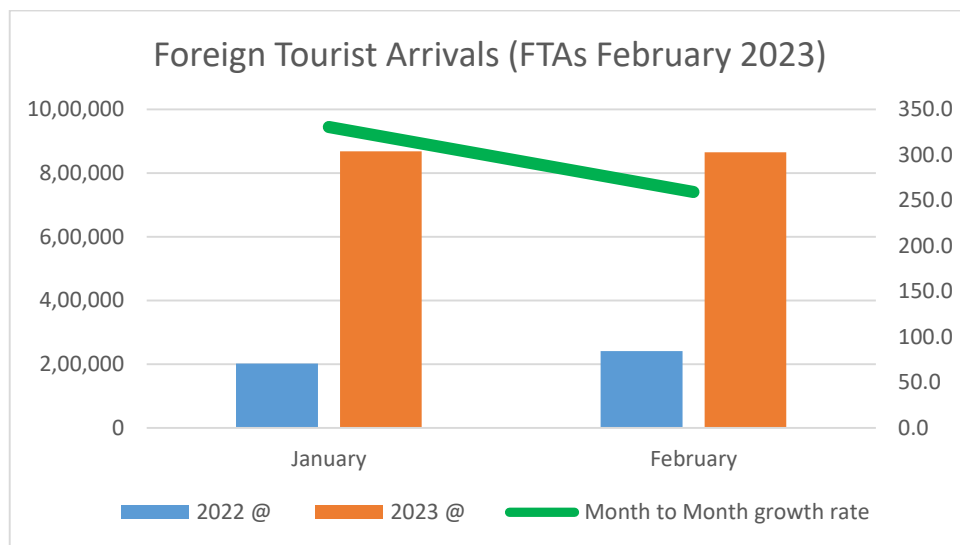
- FTAs in February, 2023 were 8,65,779 as compared to 2,40,896 in February, 2022 and 10,90,516 in February, 2019 registering a growth of 259.4% and -20.6% with respect of 2022 and 2019 respectively.

- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during February, 2023 among the top 15 source countries was highest from Bangladesh (20.3%) followed by USA (16.4%), UK (11.1%), Canada (5.8%), Australia (3.7%), Malaysia (3.0%), Sri Lanka (2.8%), Russian Federation (2.7%), Germany (2.5%), France (2.4%), Nepal (1.9%), Thailand (1.7%), Singapore (1.5%), Italy (1.2%) and Japan (1.2%).

- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during February, 2023 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (31.84%) followed by Mumbai Airport (15.53%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (10.10%), Chennai Airport (7.39%), Bengaluru Airport (5.50%), Hyderabad Airport (3.26%), Kolkata Airport (3.21%), Cochin Airport (3.04%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (2.64%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.34%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (1.63%), Amritsar Airport (1.38%), Changrabandha Land Check Post (1.37%), Sonauli Land Check Post (1.31%) and Agartala Land Check Post (1.29%).

- FTAs during the period January-February 2023 were 17,33,939 as compared to 4,42,442 in January-February, 2022 and 22,01,556 in January-February 2019 registering a growth of 291.9% and -21.2% with respect of 2022 and 2019 respectively.

- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-February, 2023 among the top 15 source countries was highest from Bangladesh (19.35%), USA (17.96%), UK (10.47%), Canada (5.91%), Australia (4.67%), Russian Federation (2.83%), Sri Lanka (2.74%), Malaysia (2.73%), Germany (2.48%), France (2.30%), Nepal (1.90%), Singapore (1.45%), Thailand (1.40%), Italy (1.22%) and Japan (1.21%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-February, 2023 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (30.74%) followed by Mumbai Airport (16.83%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (9.37%), Chennai Airport (7.76%), Bengaluru Airport (5.48%), Cochin Airport (3.44%), Hyderabad Airport (3.33%), Kolkata Airport (3.28%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.88%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (2.86%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (1.56%), Amritsar Airport (1.29%), Changrabandha Land Check Post (1.26%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.23%) and Tiruchirappalli Airport (1.18%).
