

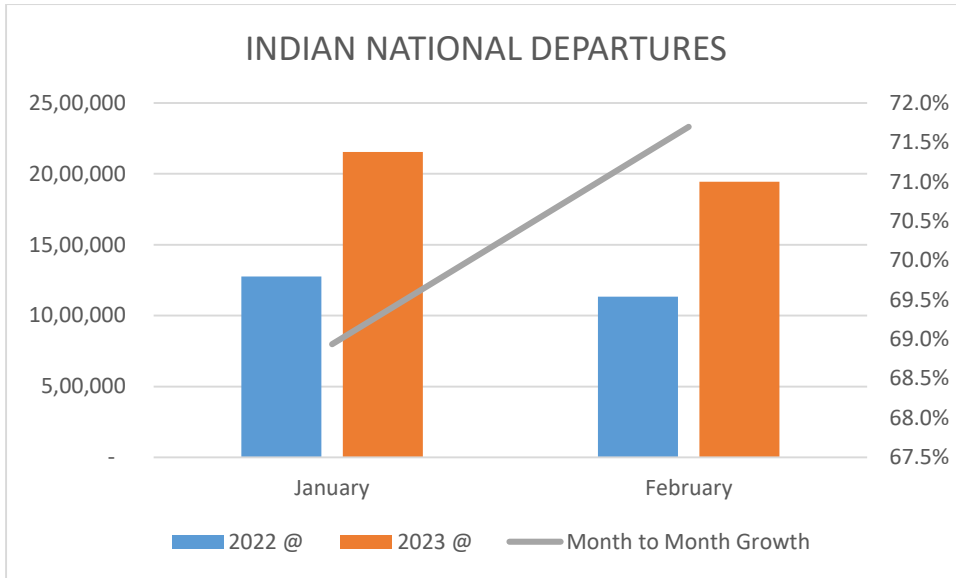
Indian National Departures February, 2023

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Indian National Departures (INDs) 2023 (Provisional) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI).

The following are the important highlights regarding Destination wise Indian National Departures (INDs) Provisional during the month of February, 2023:

Indian Nationals Departures (INDs):

- INDs in February 2023 were 19,45,637 as compared to 11,33,185 in February 2022 and 19,92,487 in February 2019 registering a growth of 71.7 % and -2.4% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during February, 2023 among the top 15 destination countries was highest for UAE (27.85%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.08%), USA (6.69%), Thailand (4.84%), Singapore (4.42%), Qatar (4.31%), UK (3.95%), Canada (3.56%), Australia (3.38%), Kuwait (3.04%), Oman (3.01%), Bangladesh (2.45%), Malaysia (1.63%), Bahrain (1.29%) and Maldives (1.28%).
- INDs in January-February 2023 were 41,01,143 as compared to 24,09,106 in January-February 2022 and 43,01,549 in January-February 2019 registering a growth of 70.2% and -4.7% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during January-February, 2023 among the top 15 destination countries was highest for UAE (27.18%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.32%), USA (7.75%), Thailand (4.69%), Singapore (4.63%), UK (4.60%), Qatar (4.07%), Canada (3.23%), Oman (3.15%), Kuwait (3.12%), Australia (2.81%), Bangladesh (2.57%), Malaysia (1.63%), Germany (1.32%) and Bahrain (1.31%).
